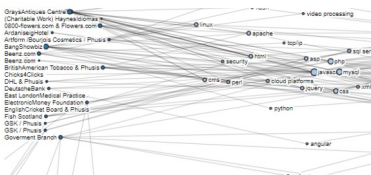

React Still great, still like lego, functional programming mindset, unopinionated, evolving

NextJS The unopinionated nature of React can lead to teams pulling in different directions, Next solves this. SSR is great, routing is better, and the Vercel deployment system makes the complicated stuff utterly painless

GraphQL BFF pattern straight out of the box. Self documenting APIs. Data validation. Type safety. Multiple varied data sources. No round trips. JSONey data structures.

Tech for 2024 cont.

Prisma Great ORM, providing type safety across entire project. Generates TypeScript classes, generates database, provides effective functions for database access. Dovetails with GraphQL

Cloudflare As well as their magic button which speeds up any site their edge based KV store can be used to great effect in bringing down page load times, and their worker functions edge compute open up many possibilities

TypeScript Any Node or JS project of over a few pages long should be using this. Type safety across the entire app, and intellisense is a productivity win

NX Mono repo manager. Perfect when spinning up multiple services. Great for micro-front-end architectures. Helpful for onboarding as developers have local environments set up easily

Cypress Front end testing has been moving towards E2E tests. Cypress works well as part of a deployment pipeline in ensuring that your critical paths remain functional in a CI/CD environment

Built invoicing system for this disrupter telco using Node, Express, Prisma, Docker. Front end team of team were struggling for months with interface. Re-wrote it using Retool within a week. Ran Agile ceremonies. Nurtured junior devs. Promoted to squad lead after 3 months.

Lampoo :: Senior Developer *May 2022 – Mar 2023*
Heading up the front end team of this Italian high end re-commerce C2C platform and auction site. Reporting to the CTO and Head of product, responsible for January delivery of platform. 50/50 split of cutting code (Next / React / Typescript / Node / GraphQL / Prisma / Headless/ Nx / Commercelayer / Algolia / DatoCMS) ensuring quality, nurturing varied team with wide geography, bringing the Agility, roadmapping, planning, mentoring and storying.

BJSS / Specsavers *2021 - 2022*
One of the largest development teams that I've encountered on this great re-platforming project, replacing a soon to be deprecated Drupal MySQL system with a Vue, Nuxt, GraphQL, Azure serverless. Working as part of the Shared Services team I produced the meganav (with particular attention to usability), then moved onto the back-end where my team wrote a centralised GraphQL gateway, using schema stitching to allow for the API to evolve and to continue to work with dozens of updates each day. Finally during my last few months there, worked with Cloudflare worker functions (javascript on the edge), which was kind of retro fun because it's all about clock cycles speed at that point, so no libraries, no Typescript :o and got typical response times down < 30ms

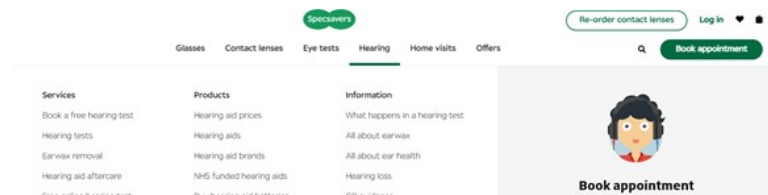

BJSS / UK Research Institute :: Senior Developer 2019

The first project which consultancy firm BJSS put me on was building a system to provide £7bn yearly funding to UK research institutions to replace the existing paper based process. React, GraphQL, Next, AWS, Typescript, Postgres. This project was deeply, purely Agile and gave me a strong orientation in how the methodology can work at its best. The best aspect for me was GDS. The primary focus on accessibility is something which I now try to bring to every project

Truck Parts Europe :: Head of Technology 2016 – 2019

Dealing with all aspects of technology across this startup business which attempted to disrupt the truck parts market. Working with PHP, MySQL and React. 600,000 products from 700 suppliers, data on 1.3m trucks down to the last nut and bolt. Typical cost saving to consumers 70%

Deutsche Bank :: Lead Developer 2018

Created online application which uses expert system to determine which of the hundreds of mortgage products available from Deutsche Bank are applicable and best suited to clients. Re-development of existing (quite horrible, jQuery) system, my team's first job was to re-write much of the code, bringing it up to date with current best practices and paradigms. Worked closely with external design team and trained team in data management best practices
